Innosuisse: What is new in 2023?

• Bottom up

- Innosuisse Innovation Projects
 - Company contribution can be down to 40%
 - Cash contribution to research partner: lowered to <mark>5%</mark> of project budget
 - Technology competence centers: Overhead may be higher percentage
- Start-up support before market entry
 - No research partner required: Up to 70% funded to Start-up by Innosuisse

• Calls

- Participation in Eurostar and EU partnership calls
 - Innosuisse covers EU part (i.e., also to companies)
- Start-up and SMEs after market entry: Swiss accelerator calls
 - No research partner required: Up to 70% for SMEs (<50 FTEs) and start-ups

Innovation projects (bottom up): Today and 2023

• Today

- 50% own contribution
- 50% Innosuisse funding

 Overhead-contribution from the research partner is a percentage of the research partner's personnel costs

• 2023

- Bandwidth for contributions between 40% and 60% and simplified calculation of the contributions; the project partners will jointly define repartition of the contributions.
- Overhead contribution new as percentage of the Innosuisse contribution
- For technology competence centers there may be a higher percentage

Innovation projects (bottom up): 2023

Research Partner

- Contribution cover 100% of the research partner's direct project costs
 - Between 60% and 40% of the total project budget
- Plus Overhead-contribution
 - Percentage of Innosuisse contribution
 - May be higher percentage for technology competence centers

• Implementation Partner

- Implementation partner brings own contribution to project
 - Between 40% and 60% of the total project budget)
 - Including 5% of the project budget as cash contribution to the research partner

Start-up (bottom up): Today and 2023

• Today

• Start-ups are subject to the same conditions as other companies in innovation projects

• 2023

 New support offer with direct project funding for start-ups before market entry

• Direct application possible for Core Coaching Prior to Core Coaching, start-up companies must have completed Initial Coaching

Start-up (bottom up): 2023

- Before market entry (New support offer): Bottom up
 - No research partner required
 - Contribution by Innosuisse to eligible project costs
 - Up to 70% (rest covered by own contributions)
 - Start-up before market entry
 - <50 FTE, <5 (10) years old, no series production

International Innovationproject calls: Today and 2023

• Today

 No direct funding contributions to companies in bilateral innovation projects, research partner must be involved

• 2023

 Direct funding contributions to companies in bilateral innovation projects possible; projects with at least one Swiss or intenational research partner

International Innovationproject calls: 2023

- EU-Partners, Eurostars: EU regulations
 - Research partner
 - Innosuisse cover max. 50% of the research partner's direct project costs, the rest covered by own contributions.
 - + overhead contribution
 - Implementation partner
 - Contributions by Innosuisse towards eligible project costs:
 - SMEs and start-ups up to 50%;
 - large companies up to 25%
 - the rest covered by own contrib.

- Eureka, Bilateral: Swiss regulations
 - Research partner
 - Innosuisse covers max. 70% of total project costs of the Swiss partners. Contributions cover max. 100% of research partner direct project costs.
 - + overhead contribution
 - Implementation partner
 - Innosuisse covers max. 70% of total project costs of the Swiss partners.
 - Contributions by Innosuisse to eligible project costs:
 - start-up: up to 70%; SME: up to 50%; large companies up to 25%
 - the rest covered by own contrib.

Start-up calls: 2023

- Post Market entry (Swiss Accelerator): Calls
 - No research partner required
 - Contribution by Innosuisse to eligible project costs
 - Up to 70% (rest covered by own contributions)
 - Only for SMEs and start-ups which are already established market players
